See you at the next meeting where Kaye Graves will be guest speaker regarding refugee health and we will be having a double induction.

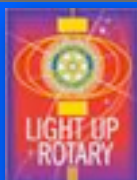

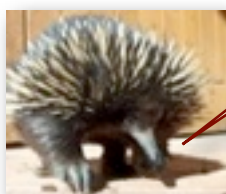

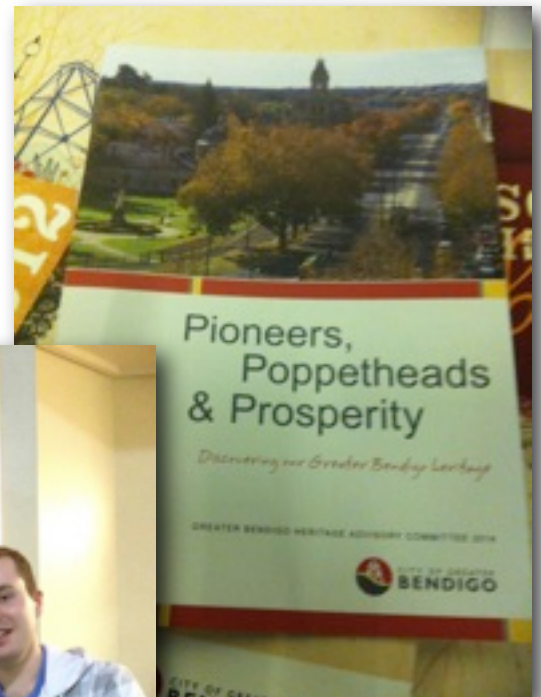
