Tour of the Shamrock Hotel including Devonshire afternoon tea on the balcony. Cost \$10.

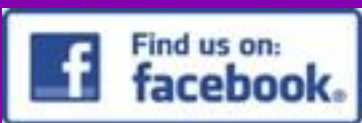

ANZAC CENTENARY COMMEMORATIVE DINNER

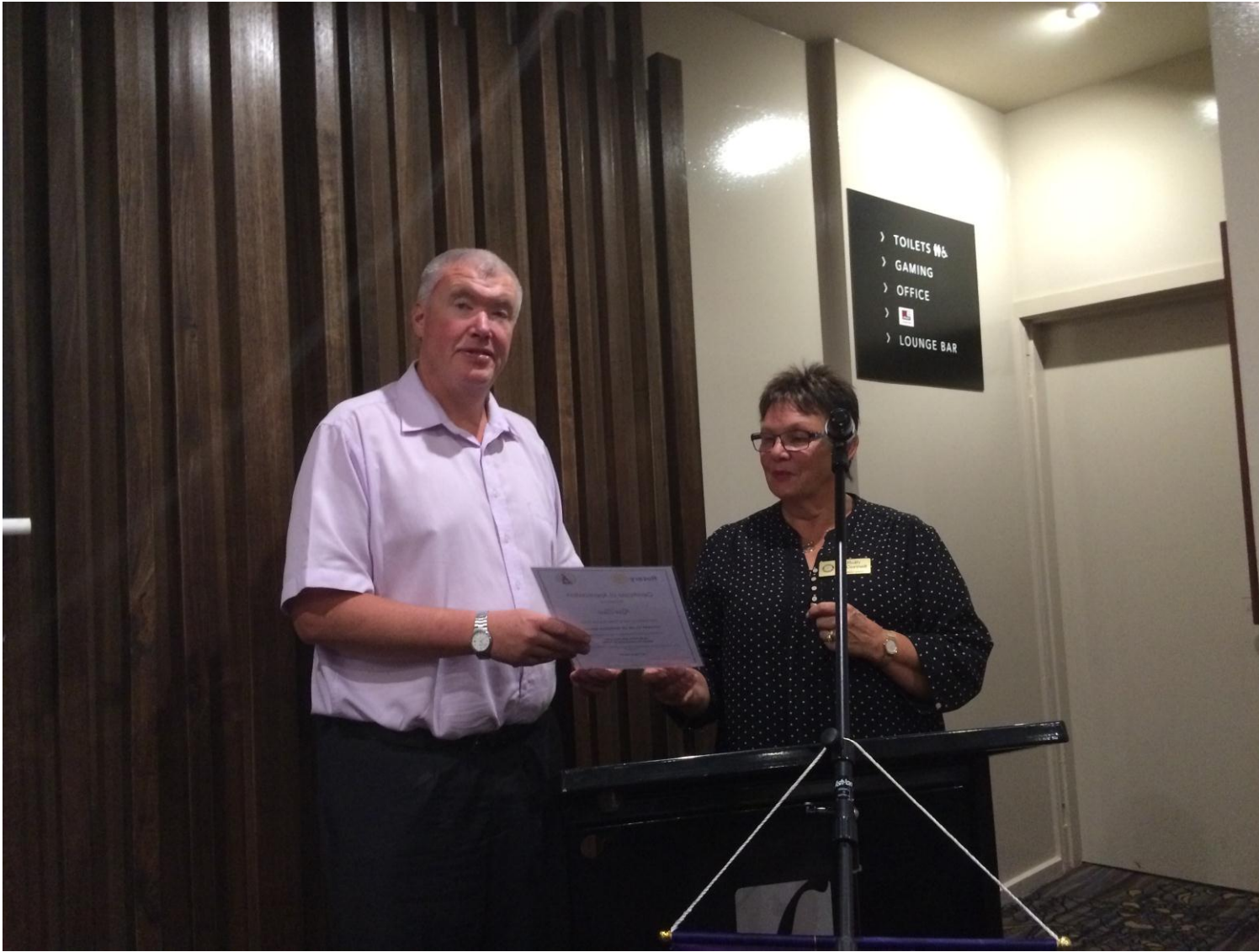
