ANZAC CENTENARY COMMEMORATIVE DINNER

Following consultation between President Rod, and the Board, it has been agreed that the Club meeting on 23rd April, 2015 will take the form of the ANZAC commemorative dinner. We will be commemorating the service and sacrifice of the Men and Women of the Australian Defence Forces over a century of wars and conflict.

This is a special time. It is 100 years since the landings at ANZAC Cove during World War One.

This is primarily a meeting for Club members and partners. Your invitation will be accompanied with some relevant information explaining the purpose of the “Dining-Out” and the procedures which are followed at the Dinner.

Members will receive a “briefing” of the Dinner procedures at the club meeting on 16th April.

Tour of Art Gallery – Sunday 26 April

The club meets at foyer and is given a guided tour of gallery and extension by a volunteer.

The Bendigo Art Gallery is considered to be one of Australia's best regional galleries.

Members are also able to inspect current exhibition of Ned Kelly which includes a good selection of Sidney Nolan artworks. After the tour, we will have a reserved table in the Café Gallery for afternoon tea.

Length of tour: 1 hr

Cost: \$12.00 (for 2 people (Bendigo residents). Afternoon tea at own expense

Wine Tour – Sunday 24 May

Tour & tasting at Balgownie Wine Estate. Members are offered a wide range of wine tasting (sparkling, white & red) as well as platters of local food circulating. There will be a talk on wine & operations from the proprietor (similar to cricketers tour). Afterwards, for those wishing to continue the adventure, a Connor Park visit will be available.

Time: 12 noon – 3pm

Length of tour: 2 hrs (plus 1 Hr Connor Park if selected)

Cost: \$25 - \$30pp

Shamrock Hotel Tour – Sunday 14 June

Members will meet in the hotel foyer and will be provided with a tour of the hotel from cellar to top floor and shown a wide range of rooms in the hotel, both function and accommodation.

This is a very famous building with a heritage listing and the tour offers expert commentary. Afterwards, members are given a voucher for afternoon tea in the hotel café for coffee and cake

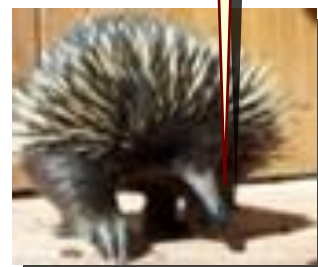
Time: 2pm – 3.30pm
