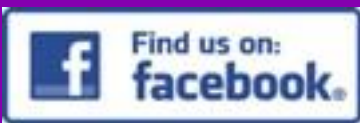
The Rotary Year is rapidly drawing to a close, and the Board had its last meeting before handover. I wish to thank the Board for all their hard work and making the year a success.

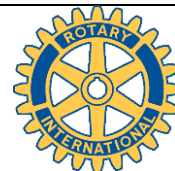
