Rick from RMIT University Flight School presented a history of 30 years of flying in Northern Australia and the Pacific archipelago. He has worked in many places including New Guinea and the Solomon Islands where air transport is fundamental to the operation of these areas. As a retired pilot, he now lectures at Point Cook and the RMIT Flight School in Bendigo. His presentation was extremely interesting and there were several questions and discussion that followed. The key message is that there is a shortage of at least 50,000 pilots worldwide as a result of COVID.

The decision to cancel the physical meeting due to the extreme rainfall event, outlined the benefit of a zoom meeting where conditions of travel for members were clearly unsafe at that time. There were 14 members that tuned in at short notice plus 3 members who were filling sandbags for flood affected areas.
